**Ron Piggott Interviewed By
Melanie on December 2nd 2011**



Melanie: Ron Piggott knows the power of encouragement, especially the power of God's word in healing weary souls. His passion for encouraging others motivated him to learn to write web site codes and create a web site to introduce people to the healing power and love of God. Ron welcome to UCB Canada.

Ron: Thank you very much Melanie.
Melanie: Now can you describe the web site you have created?

Ron: Yes I would be glad to. What I have focused on is a 'Verse of the Day' web site. The web site revolves around a daily devotional and then there are various Bible study tools, activities and other devotionals for people to use. The purpose or hope is to get people into God's word and looking to Him in their daily lives.

Melanie: There are literally millions of web sites, but this web site is unique

because the creator is unique. Ron is confined to a wheelchair due to a physical condition that includes, at times, extreme pain, and makes it impossible for him to work many hours each day. Ron how does this tie into your web site? How does your life style, what you have been through and continue to go through tie into what you have created?

Ron: What's been on my mind very heavily is 2 Corinthians 1:3-4

"Blessed by the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our affliction so that we will be able to comfort those who are in any affliction with the comfort with what we ourselves are comforted by God" (NASB)

During the challenges I have gone through I have become comfortable looking to the Lord, to pray for and commit the concerns I have each day with my health and the pain I go through. What I have tried to do is share the encouraging Bible verses that have helped me and other thoughts I have reflected on during the past few years in learning to trust that God is there and also be able to know and accept that the Lord is able to handle our problems. Even though it is hard coming to God and saying "I'm weak" He is indeed faithful during these times to look to Him for hope and courage to keep going. What I have done and hope to share is the hope I have found with the people who come online and give them hope each day to face their lives.
